JO BERRY and PAT MAGEE *Making friends with 'the enemy'*

Jo Berry's father, Sir Anthony Berry MP, was killed in the 1984 IRA Brighton Bombing during the 1984 Tory Party Conference. Jo has since visited Ireland many times and worked with victims and former combatants from all sides. In November 2000 she met Pat Magee, the man responsible for her father's death.

Belfast-born Pat Magee, a former IRA activist, was given multiple life sentences for the Brighton Bombing. Released under the Good Friday Agreement in 1999, he has since been actively involved in peace work.

This evening challenges the knee-jerk reactions of anger and blame, and shows how the deeper roots of war, terrorism and violence can be addressed through understanding, dialogue and a peaceful non-violent approach.
